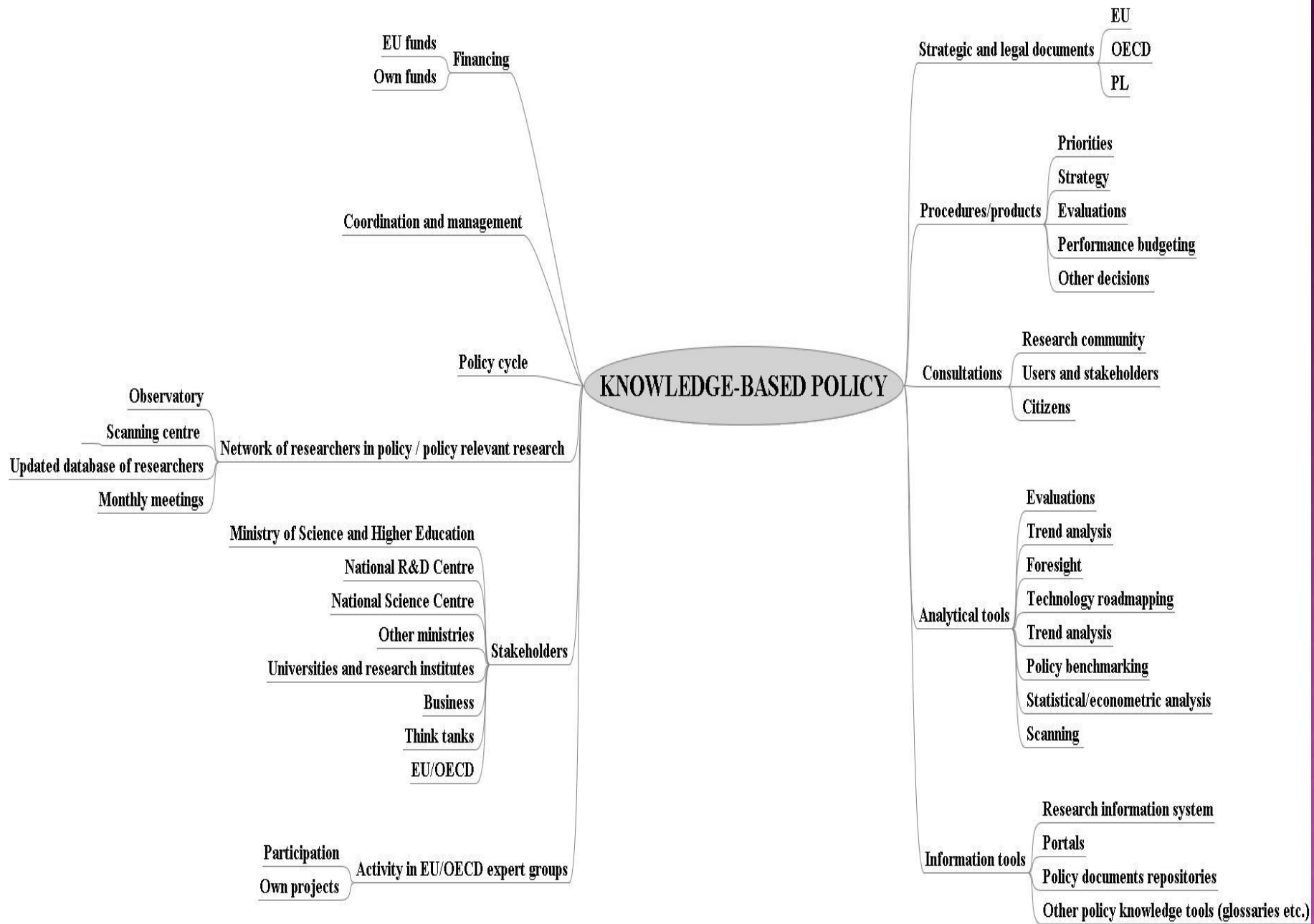

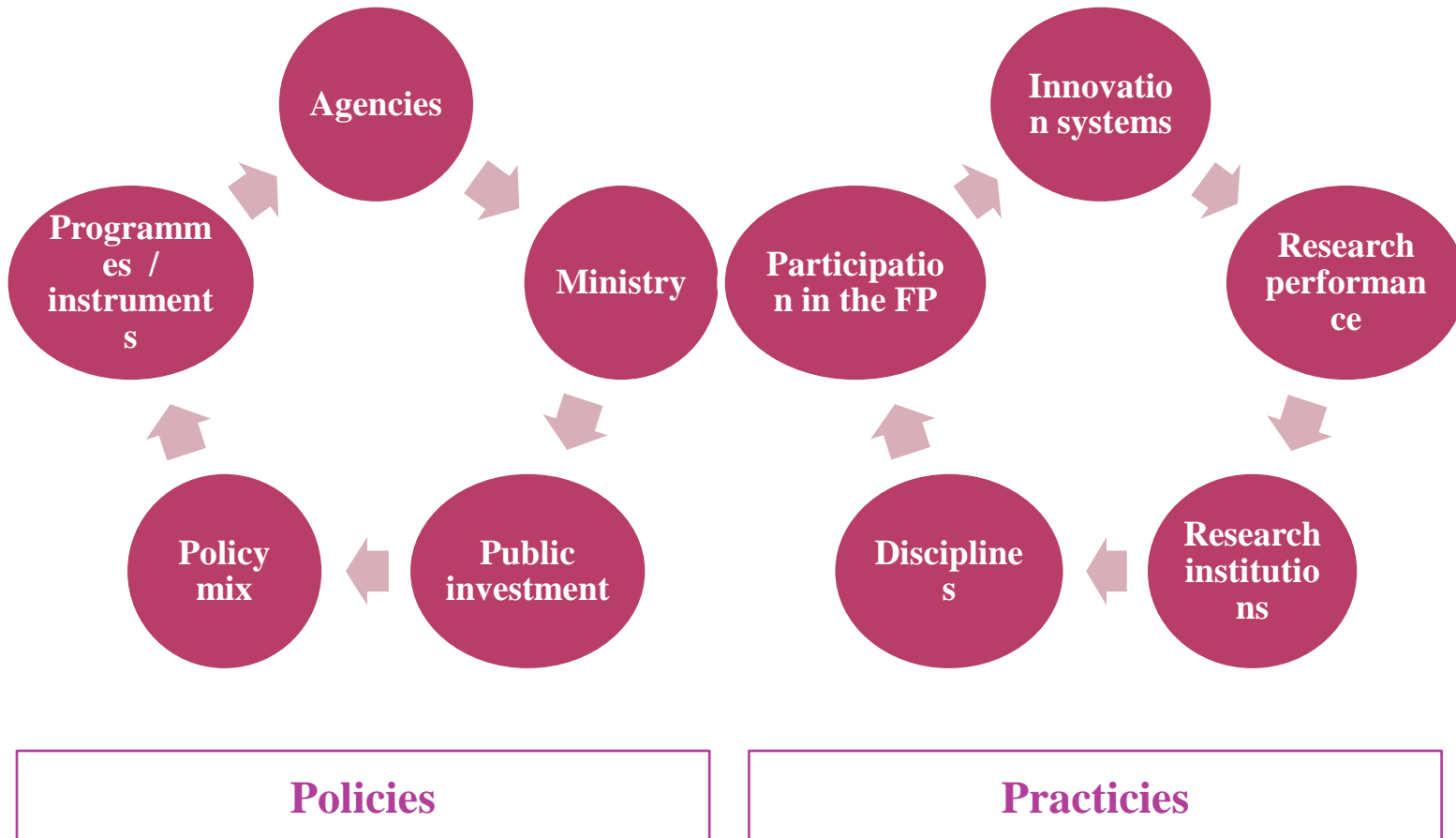

INSTITUTIONAL EVALUATION: STRENGTHS & DEFICIENCIES OF EXISTING SYSTEM

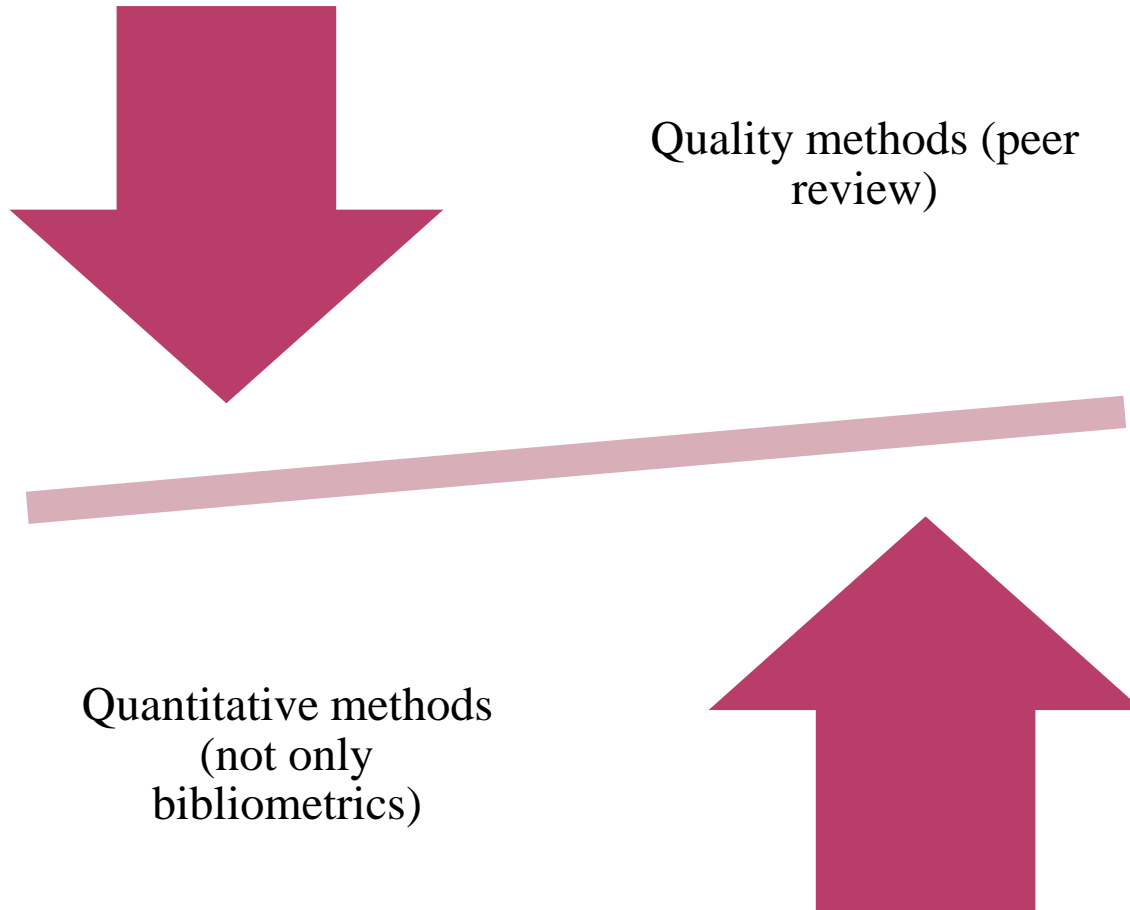
- One of the first performance-based systems of public research funding in Europe

- Excessive importance of
 - Product evaluation (publications, patents) / effects and impacts
 - Quality evaluation / relevance and utility
- Excessive homogenisation
 - Specificity of disciplines, missions and statuses of institutions
- Excessive stress on competition / cooperation
- Not sufficient professionalism, infrastructure, evaluation culture

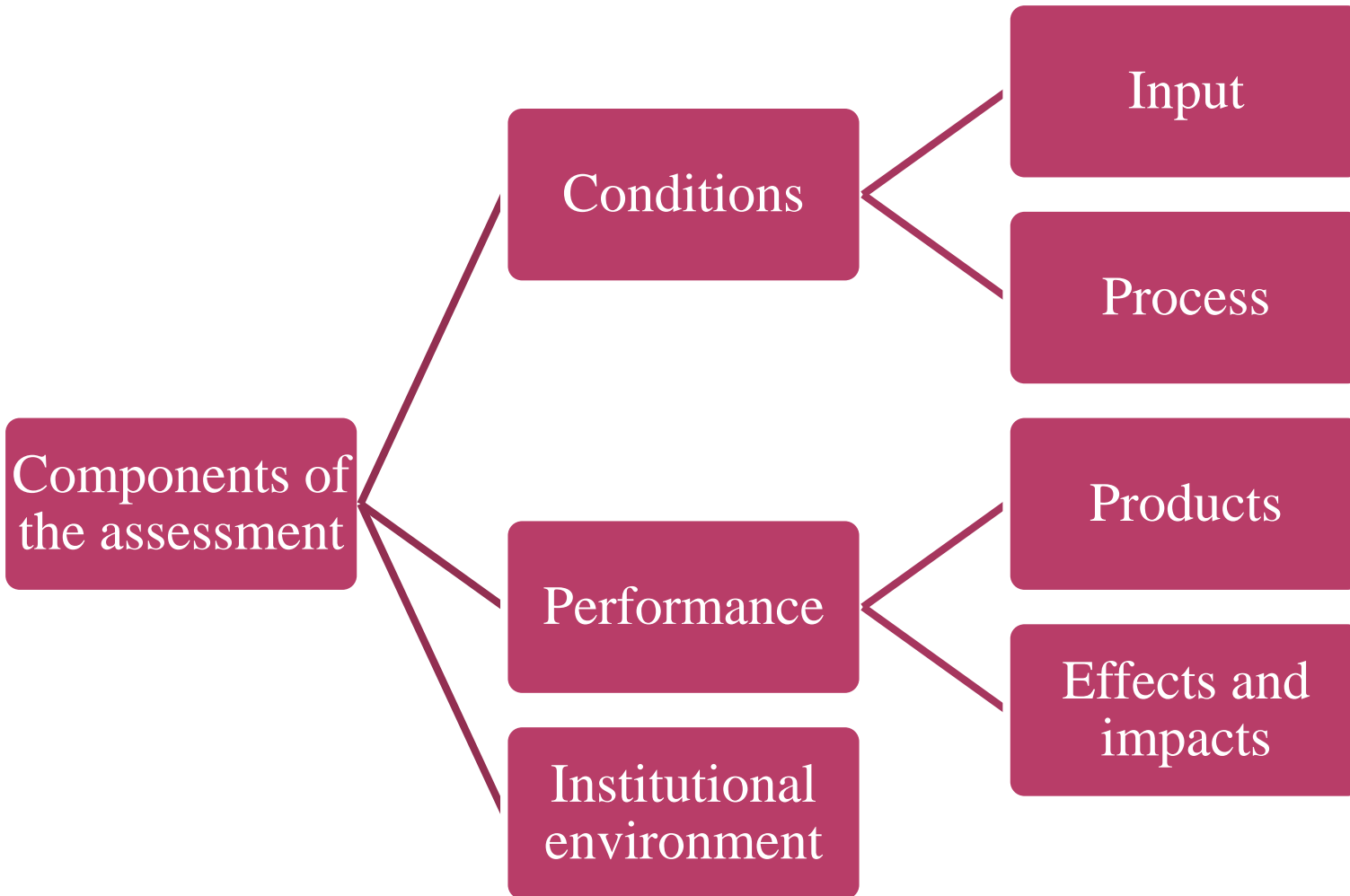

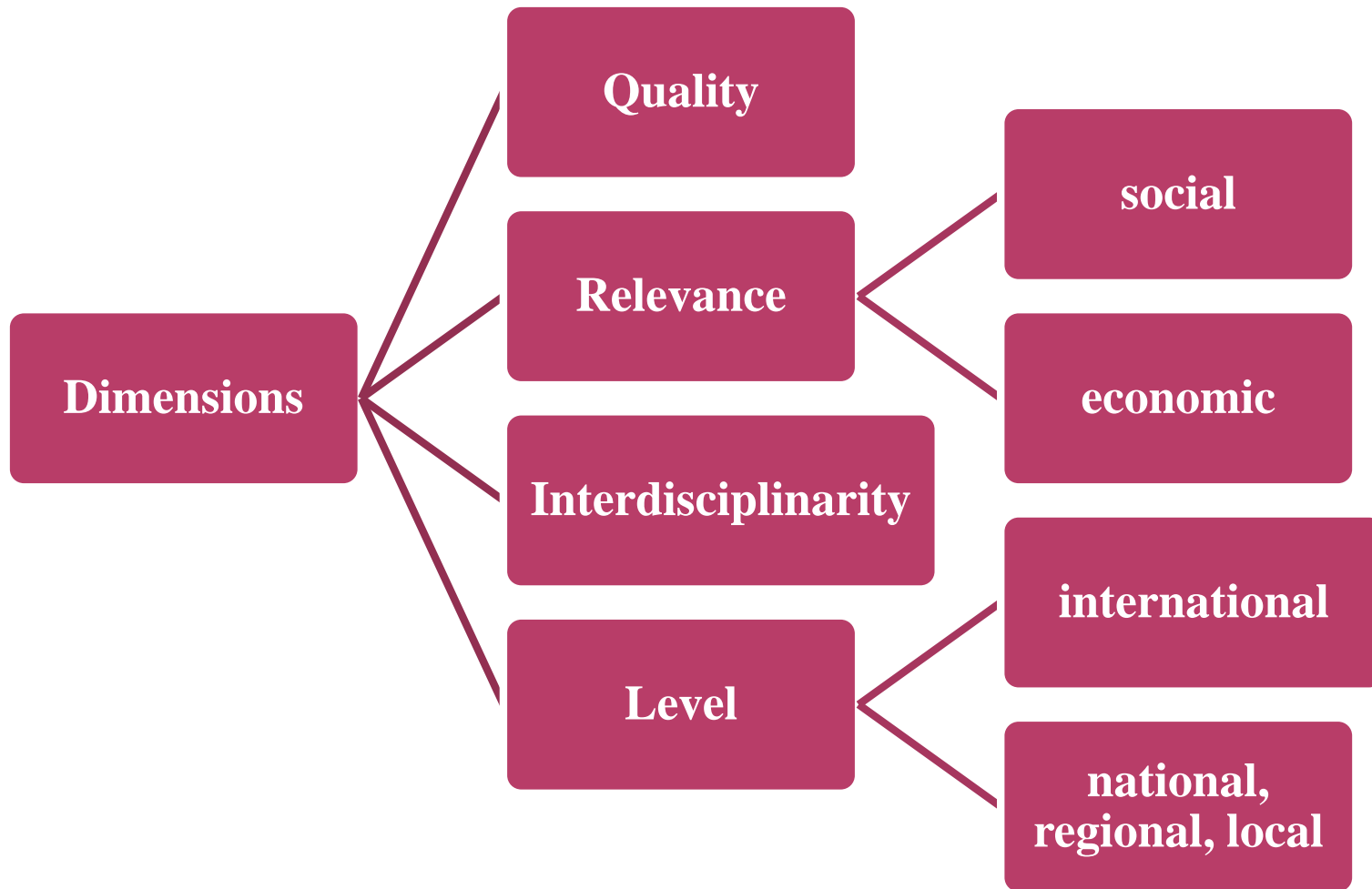
